
Albuquerque Vipassana Sangha presents a residential retreat:

She has also studied with Thich Nhat Hanh in the Zen tradition, Punjaji in the Advaita tradition and Tsokney Rinpoche in the Dzogchen tradition. She is the founding teacher of Dhamma Dena Meditation Center (now Insight Meditation Center of the Pioneer Valley/Dhamma Dena). She is co-author of the book, *A Beginner's Guide to Insight Meditation*. She teaches throughout the U.S. and Europe.
