



Driving Directions:

From I-25, take Rio Bravo exit and head west.
Continue on Rio Bravo Blvd. to Coors Blvd.
Turn left (south) on Coors Blvd.
Continue on Coors Boulevard past Gun Club Road.
Soon after passing Pajarito Road, turn right (west) at small white sign for Norbertine Center.
Follow the dirt road a short distance to the Norbertine Center
